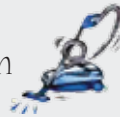


GARBAGE



- **Styrofoam™**
- Empty aerosol cans
- Chip bags, candy wrappers
- Cereal box liners
- Light bulbs
- Clothing, boots and shoes
- Broken glass, ceramics and porcelain (wrapped and clearly marked)
- **Pet litter, animal waste**
- Broken toys
- Microwave popcorn bags
- **Empty** paint cans (lids removed)
- Bulky waste (mattresses, rugs, upholstered furniture, vacuum cleaners etc.)



HAZARD WASTE DEPOT



Located at:
243 Sandy Point Road

Open: 1st and 3rd Monday of each month*
9am - 4pm (closed 1pm - 2pm)

* If regularly scheduled Monday falls on a Holiday the Depot will be open on Tuesday

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:
Household cleaners, acid batteries, pesticides, fuels, waste oil, propane tanks, paint (paint may also be returned to BOWOOD INC.)

ORGANIC



All food waste including:

- Meat, including bones
- **Fruit and vegetable waste***
- Dairy products
- Cooking oil and fat
- **Egg shells***
- Seafood shells
- **Bread and other grains***
- **Coffee grounds, filters and tea bags***
- Paper plates, cups and towel
- Paper sugar, flour and potato bags
- Waxed paper
- **Soiled paper towel/napkins***
- Soiled pizza boxes
- Boxboard and waxed boxes
- **Grass, leaves and plant waste***
- Branches/brush (3' x 1")
- Sawdust and wood shavings
- Human and pet hair
- **Cold** stove ashes



*All items highlighted in green may also be placed in a **BACKYARD COMPOST PILE.**

If you line your cart you must use only certified compostable bags clearly marked with this logo

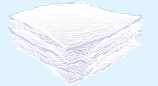


Regular plastic in the green cart will be rejected !!

RECYCLE



- All plastic and plastic containers, clean and dry
- **Aluminum pie plates, foil**
- Frozen food bags, milk bags
- Milk cartons
- **Hot beverage cups including Tim Hortons™**
- Corrugated cardboard (flattened and bundled)
- Newspaper, flyers, catalogues
- Clean pizza boxes
- Paperback/hardcover books
- Computer/office paper
- Egg cartons
- Aluminum/tin cans
- Glass jars and bottles
- Plastic shopping bags, bread bags
- Toilet paper, paper towel tubes
- **Pop bottles, juice boxes***
- **Liquor bottles***
- **Juice cans***



*Beverage containers can be returned to BOWOOD INC. for a refund.

Open: Tuesday - Saturday
9:30am - 4:00pm
(closed for holidays)

Tipping fee is \$ 60.00 per tonne



Acceptable Materials:

All materials must be separated into the following streams

1. Wood
2. Shingles
3. Gypsum board/drywall
4. Vinyl/plastic building materials, carpeting, built up roofing, ceiling tiles, vinyl floor & linoleum, wiring, lighting fixtures, fibreglass and Styrofoam™ insulation

Items that are free of charge:

- scrap metal*
- metal appliances*
- wire lobster traps*
- leaf and yard waste
- rope



* Scrap metal and metal appliances are also picked up at curbside during Spring and Fall Metal Collections.

→ All construction waste can be taken to the Regional Materials Recovery Facility



→ Propane tanks and other hazardous materials can be taken to the HHW depot



→ Computers, televisions, monitors, printers, VCRs, fax machines and other electronics can be taken to **BOWOOD INC.**
