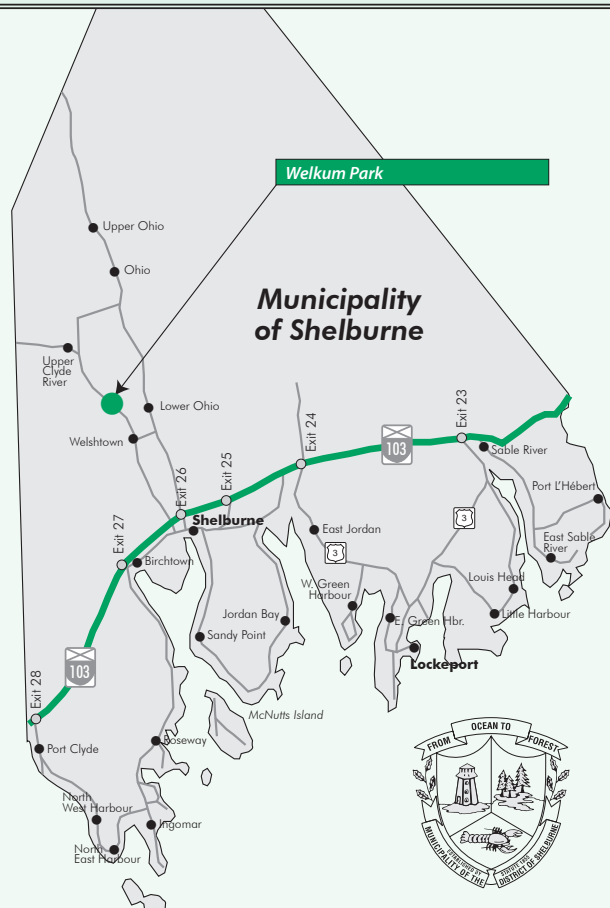
General Information:
