PROGRAM PICK UP & DROP OFF

Staff are on site 30 minutes before camp starts and will remain on site until the last child is picked up. Upon request, staff can be on site as early as 8am for drop-off and 5pm for pick-up. Children are supervised the entire time they are at camp.

CAMP CHECKLIST

How swimming lessons are scheduled:
 Swimming lessons are scheduled based on the levels being taught and the number of participants. For example, Level 1 lessons will be scheduled at a different time than Level 5. Levels that are close (i.e. Levels 1&2 may be combined if registration numbers are manageable). Actual lesson times are determined once the majority of registrations have been received. Staff will contact you with the time the week before.
Pre-School Lessons - Parents are strongly encouraged to get in the water with children under the age of 4 at swimming lessons.
