Recently it has come to my attention, upon receiving my voter card in the mail, that my residence falls under the jurisdiction of District #1. I currently reside at 1568 Lake Road in Sandy Point. For years this area was part of District #3, then later we became District #4. You can certainly appreciate my surprise, when now I discover that I live in District #1 which is many kilometres from my home. From research I have conducted, I have been advised that this was a decision made in 2015 – passed by the current Council then onto the Province for their seal of Approval. I do not ever recall receiving any sort of notification advising of this change and whereas the Municipal Elections in 2016 were all acclaimed there would have been no notification at that time either.

To say the very least, I am very disappointed and upset with Council for these changes. If numbers were short in District #1, then why not realign District #2 and so on (in my mind this would have made more sense) – instead of taking a few of us from this area and plunking us in District #1.
